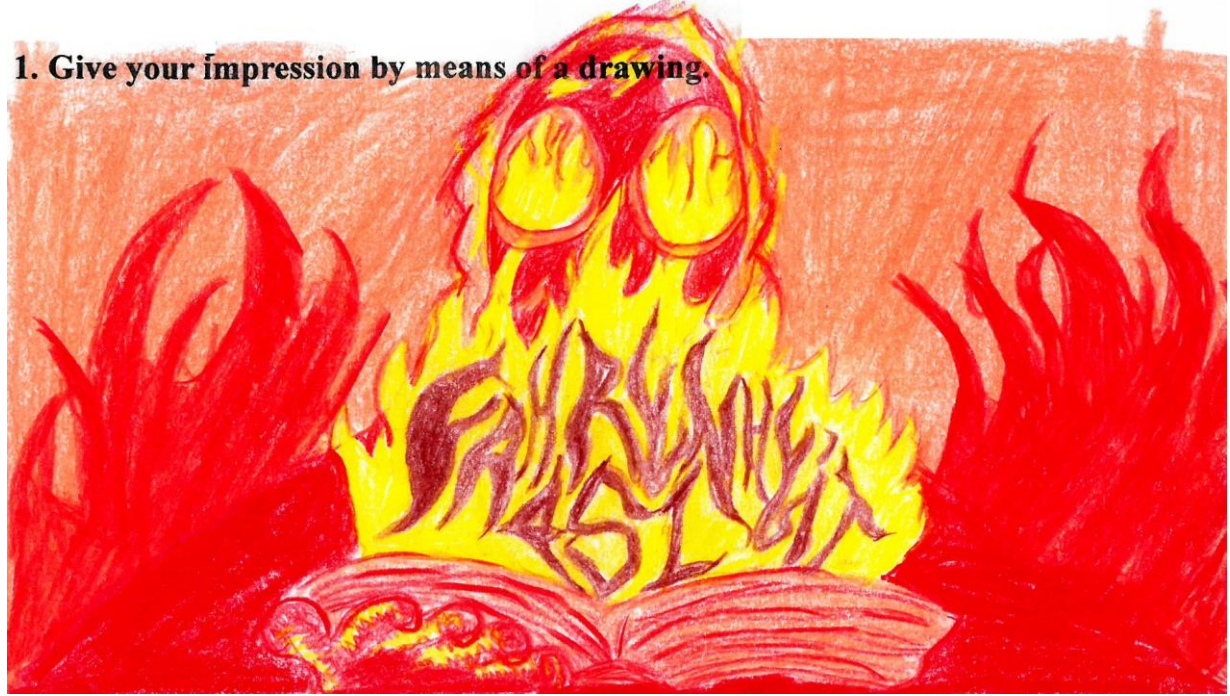

3. Comment and Sharing: (about 100 words)
