Book Title: Wonder

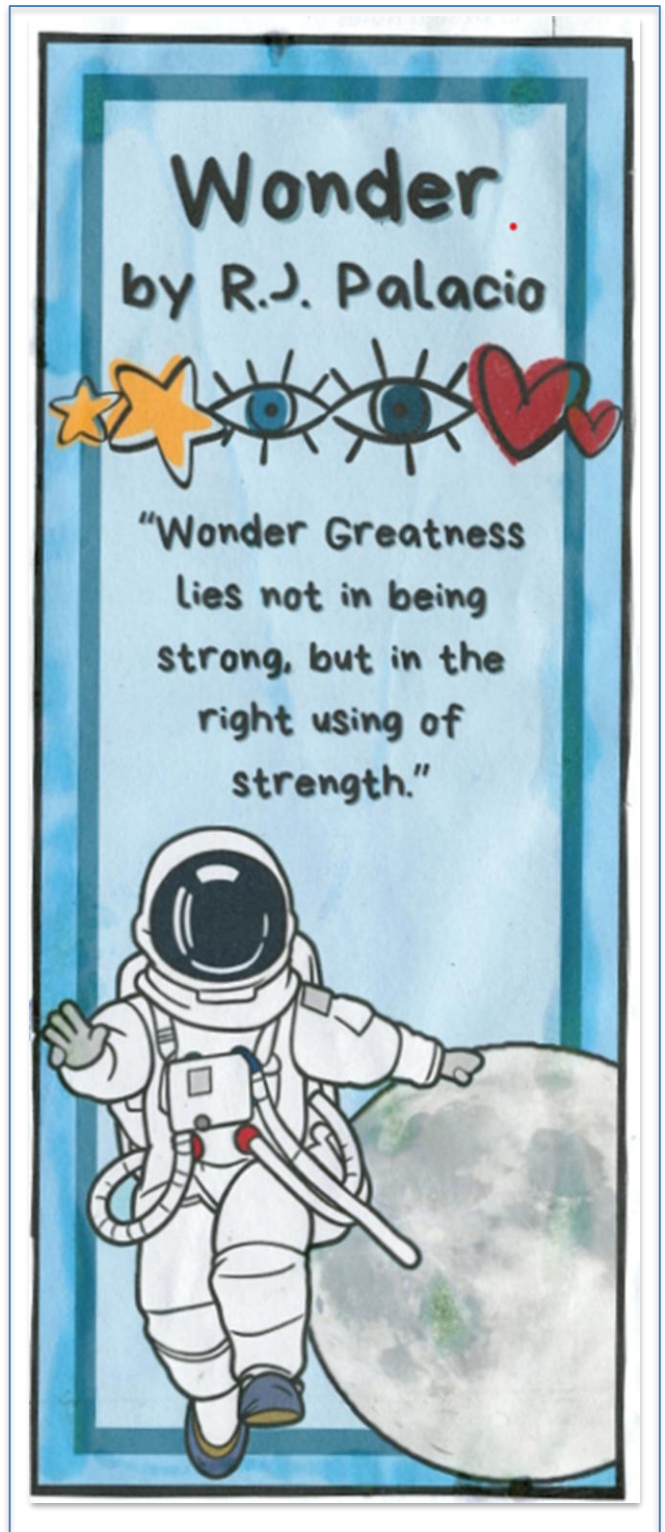
The quote:

Book Title: The Little Prince

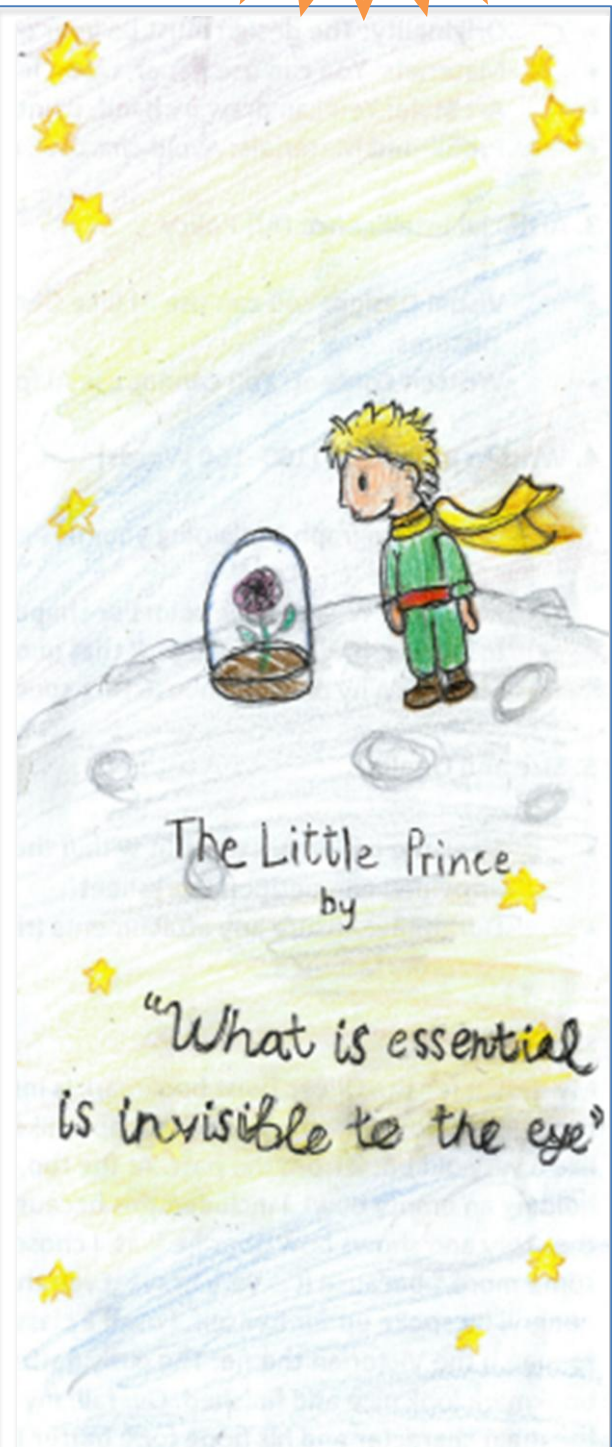
The quote:

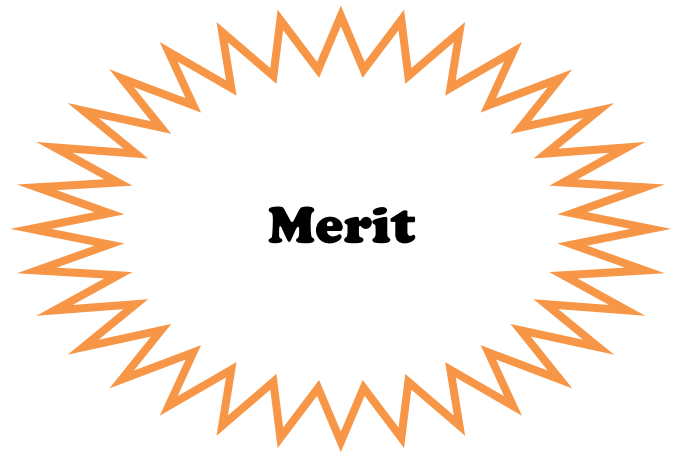

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

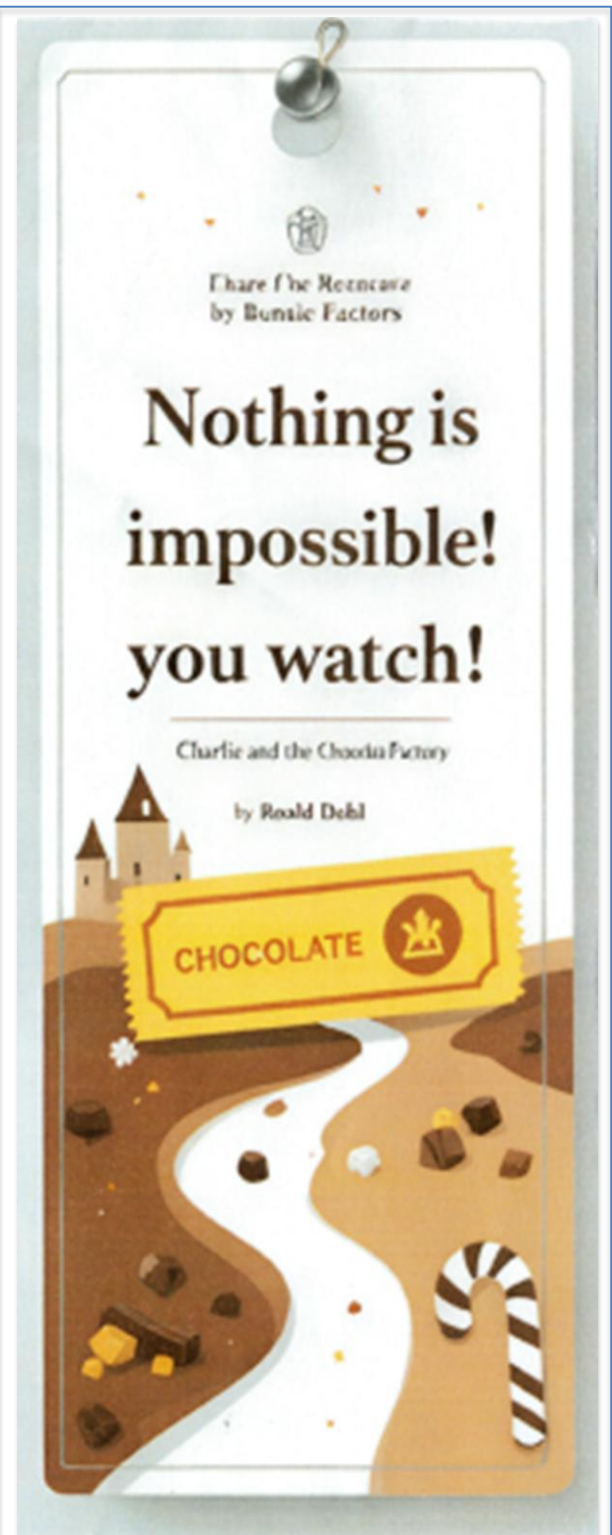
The quote:

“What are you doing to my cottage?”

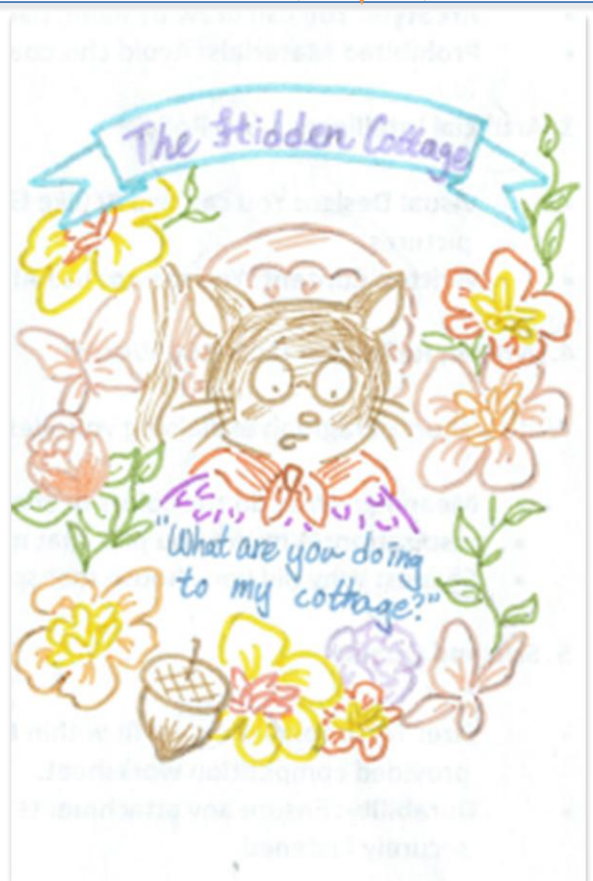

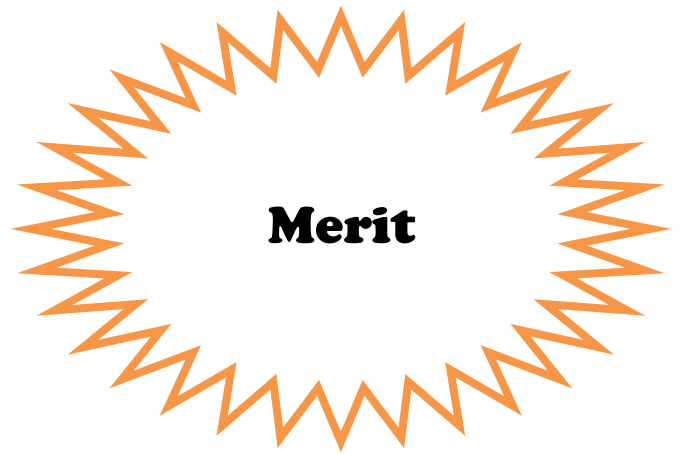

Overall, I used a cartoon style to present the start of Charlie's amazing experience.



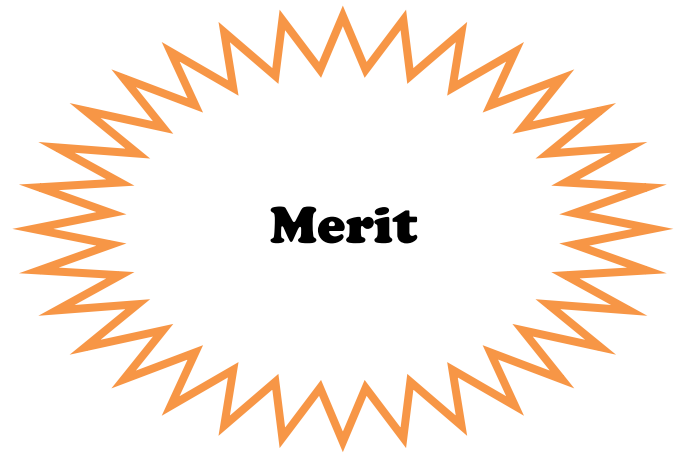

The quote:

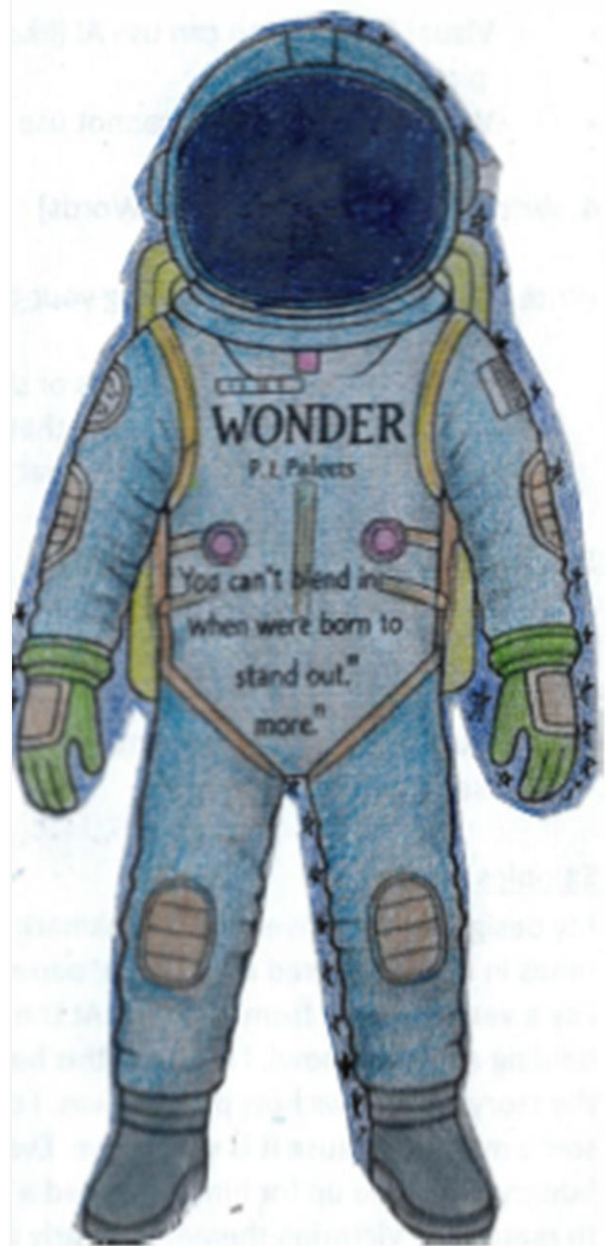
“You can’t blend in when were born to stand out.”

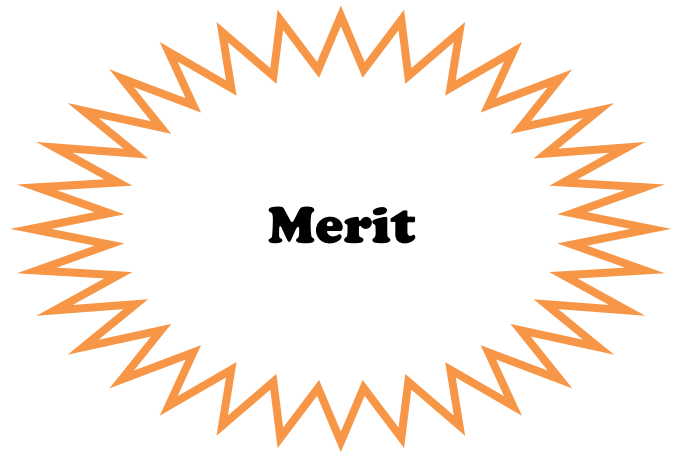
